OPEN AND AFFIRMING EVENT IN 2024!

FIRST CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH

Manchester

Our first 2024 after-worship Conversation will be held on **Sunday, February 4th**. We will be joined by Jace Troie, DEI & Program Assistant of NAMI NH (National Alliance on Mental Illness). NAMI NH is a grassroots organization working to improve the lives of all people affected by

mental illness and suicide through support, education, and advocacy. Jace will join us for a wide-ranging conversation. Several of his planned topics are listed below.

 Jace will give an overview about NAMI NH (who they are, what they do, why they are focused on DEI (Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion).

- He has offered to share his lived experience as a transgender man and as someone who has a mental health diagnosis. Jace has faced many challenges, among them being homeless and developing and recovering from a substance use disorder.
- He will provide data and information on local youth mental health and LGBTQ+ community and will include information on risks and protective factors that are important for *all* youth, young and older adults.
- Jace will talk with our faith community about what it means to be an ally.

As with previous Conversations, time for questions and discussion will be provided and we will offer a light luncheon during our time of Conversation.




